

Middle Gate Conducts 'Souper' Bowl Collection

Cans of soup collected by the Middle Gate Elementary School community were gathered and delivered to the Food Pantry at Social Services at Town Hall South on Friday, February 3, for the school's "Souper' Bowl food drive.

Ann Benore, case manager/administrative assistant at Social Services, said on Friday the food pantry can use donations of cans of soup, spaghetti, canned raviolis, canned chili, canned stew, and cans of pork and beans. She also said donations of macaroni and cheese, any brand, are popular.
